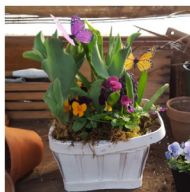

ANGELONIA 'ANGELFACE'

Sun. Blooms all season; heat and drought tolerant plants; grape-scented foliage; low maintenance. Deer resistant



BIDENS CAMPFIRE FLAME

Vigorous and heat tolerant with striking scarlet/yellow flowers in the summer and muted orange petals in early spring and fall. Attracts: Bees



CALIBRACHOA 'SUPERBELLS DREAMSICLE'

I'm pretty AND I create oxygen. Abundant, small petunia-like flowers all season on cascading growth, no deadheading necessary. Continuous Bloom. Heat Tolerant Deadheading Not Necessary Attracts: Hummingbirds



COLEUS 'COLORBLAZE WICKED WITCH'

Deep Burgundy to Chocolate foliage with a ruffled edge outlined in chartreuse with well-branched plants. Sun to shade tolerant and great in both landscapes and containers. It is late to bloom, which helps preserve the foliage presentation throughout the season.



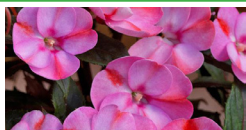
DICHONDRA SILVER FALLS

Vigorous, fan-shaped silver foliage on silver stems; very heat and drought tolerant. Very strongly trailing plant is a fun component in baskets and other planters.



IMPATIENS SUNPATIENS 'COMP PINK CANDY'

Part Sun to Sun. Colorful plants with large flowers. Continuous Bloom. Heat Tolerant Deadheading Not Necessary. Great for containers and/or landscape



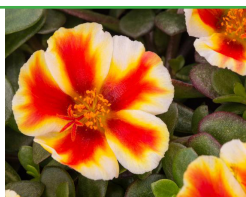
IMPATIENS SD BEACON

High resistance to Impatiens downy mildew! Plant in Shade, Partial Sun (less than 3 hrs of sun) Plant in full shade for best performance. Do not over water or overfertilize - will reduce flowering.



ISOTOMA FIZZ N POP GLOWING VIOLET

A new variety of Laurentia, featuring nectar-rich blooms. Great for beneficial pollinating insects! Perfect for containers, borders and mass landscape planting.



PORTULACA COLORBLAST MANGO MOJITO

Full Sun. Attracts Butterflies & Hummingbirds, Double Flower, Drought Tolerant, Heat Tolerant, No Deadheading, Trailing.



SALVIA MYSTY

Covered with true blue flowers all season, the dark green-leaved plants are naturally more compact, well-branched and very free-flowering. Heat-hardy plants Ideal for middle of the garden borders and mixed containers.



Frostkiss Hellebore 'Cheryl's Shine'

Hellebores are frost resistant, bloom in winter/early spring, shade tolerant, deer resistant and evergreen. They are the harbinger of spring. We select hellebores that are vigorous, have a long period of bloom, large number of blossoms, outward facing flowers and have a rich color.



Heuchera - Primo 'Peachberry Ice'

Heuchera - Primo series are valued for their size, intense colors, mounded growth habit and are very fast growing. Sun or shade, salt tolerant, attracts Bees, Butterflies and resists deer Native to North America



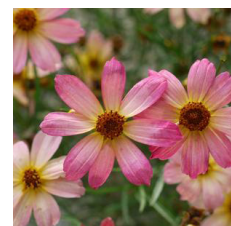
Lupinus - Lupine

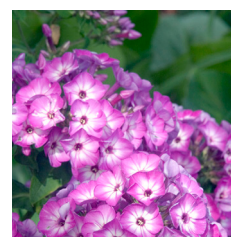
Monarda Bee You 'Bee Happy' - red

2020 Perennial Plant of the Year Aralia 'Sun King'



BEHOLD, THE SUN KING! No, not Louis XIV of France, rather, a fabulous high-impact perennial. Aralia 'Sun King' brings a bold pop of glowing color and texture - the perfect anchor for the shade to shade-to-part-shade border. "Discovered" by plantsman Barry Yinger in a Japanese garden center (atop a department store), this perennial has become a beloved shade garden staple across the country. Bright yellow shoots emerge in spring, then grow up, up, up...can reach 6' tall and nearly as wide. The small, cream-colored umbels of flowers are attractive to bees and are followed by tiny dark (inedible) drupes. Despite the Sun King's stature, it's very well behaved - little to no reseeding or suckering.

Part shade to full shade. A few hours of sun brings out the yellow; tends to be more chartreuse in deeper shade. **SOIL** Not picky - but can flag during dry spells, so provide additional water as necessary.

USES Terrific in combination with hosta, ferns, and a knockout when placed near Acer palmatum 'Blood-good' or other maroon-leaf woody. And don't forget containers - Sun King is bold & beautiful in a big pot!

2020 Hosta of the Year Hosta 'Dancing Queen'

Bright yellow foliage is broad and wedge-shaped with a rippled edge. Turns pale yellow later in the season. Pale lavender flowers in mid-summer.

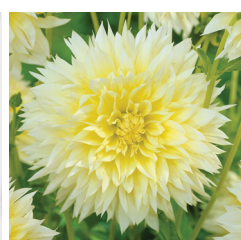

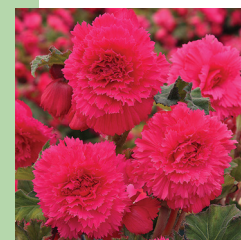

UNDERSTANDING PLANT NUTRITION courtesy of ESPOMA

Nineteen elements are considered essential for plant growth. Carbon, hydrogen, and oxygen are primarily supplied by air and water. Plant roots absorb the remaining 16 elements from the surrounding soil. These elements are divided into three groups based on their relative abundance in plants: Primary Nutrients (or Major Nutrients), Secondary Nutrients (or Minor Nutrients), and Trace Nutrients (or Micronutrients). Although the Major Nutrients are needed in the greatest quantities, a deficiency of any one nutrient can prevent plant growth, or reduce it to unsatisfactory levels. Even though some soils may already contain these nutrients, they may not be in a form available for plant growth. The best way to ensure that all of the nutrients are available in the soil is through regular applications of plant foods. The table below provides more information on each nutrient, its deficiency symptoms, and possible plant foods to cure the deficiency.
